Name of Town Council: Mold Town Council **Introduction and Context** Mold Town Council is the local authority serving the vibrant market town of Mold, located in Flintshire, North Wales. Nestled at the foot of the Clwydian Range – an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty – Mold is a historic town known for its rich cultural heritage, strong community spirit, and thriving local economy. The town is conveniently situated approximately 10 miles west of the English border, and just 12 miles from the city of Chester, making it a key centre within North East Wales. It offers a mix of traditional charm and modern amenities, with attractions including the renowned Mold Market, Theatr Clwyd, and numerous independent shops and eateries. Mold Town Council represents the interests of residents, supports local services and events, and works in partnership with other organisations to enhance the wellbeing and prosperity of the town.
