Mold Town Council Festive Santa Dash Event – Terms & Conditions

By entering Mold Town Council Santa Dash event you agree to abide by these Conditions of Entry and any race instructions given to you by the organisers and officials of the event.

Entry Fee: The entry fee is non-refundable once accepted. The event cannot consider personal circumstances or requests for refunds. No transfer of places to another runner will be considered. It is not possible to defer entries from one year to the next.

Medical treatment while attending the event.

By entering the event you are confirming that should you require non-emergency medical treatment during your participation then it will be administered by volunteers from St John's Ambulance.

Data protection.

Personal details secured by Mold Town Council as part of your entry procedure will only be used by Mold Town Council in connection with the event and future events organised by Mold Town Council and news relating to the Town Council. Information <u>will not</u> be passed to any third parties, with the exception of any medical information you have provided that may be necessary on the day for your own welfare.

Santa Suit / Race attire

All participants 12 years and over will be offered a Santa Suit which is one size only (adult size). If required, adult participants can wear their own Santa suit and children (under 16 years) can wear alternative festive costume, but all race attire must be in keeping with the festive theme. There will be no reduction on entry free for participants wearing their own costume.

Race ejection.

Mold Town Council reserve the right, at it's absolute discretion, to refuse to allow any participation that may be considered to cause offence or injury to the participant, other participants or spectators. This includes the wearing of any clothing or visual messages that may cause offence to others. Failure to comply with any instruction from event officials will result in ejection from the race and possible intervention of North Wales Police.

Bicycles, stilts, roller skates and similar contraptions.

The event is classified as a footrace (save for permissible wheelchair entries) and as such none of the contraptions mentioned above are allowed. Any attempt to use any of the above may result in disqualification of the individual(s).

Dogs

With the exception of assistance dogs, dogs are not permitted to join participants in the race.



Water and rubbish disposal

Water will be supplied at designated areas for all race participants. All participants are to dispose of water bottles and any other rubbish in the bins provided and not dispose on the ground.

Event cancellation.

Mold Town Council reserves the right, at it's absolute discretion, to cancel, delay or postpone the event due to unforeseen circumstances outside of the reasonable control of Mold Town Council.

In such cases Mold Town Council will endeavour to inform participants as quickly as possible regarding the appertaining situation. Should the event be cancelled, delayed or postponed due to circumstances outside of the reasonable control of Mold Town Council (including, for the avoidance of doubt, due to adverse weather conditions or as a result of instruction from the Emergency Services) Mold Town Council will not be liable for any inconvenience, expenses, costs, losses or damages suffered by participants. Entry fee is non refundable and is part of organisers commitment to the 'Mayor's Fundraising Appeal' in support of the Bailey Hill restoration.

Where the event has to be cancelled, delayed or postponed due to circumstances that were within the reasonable control of Mold Town Council, the entire liability will be limited to the entry fee that has been paid to take part.

Music Devices.

For Health and Safety reasons you must not participate and use any personal entertainment listening devices. This is particularly important so as to allow any of the Emergency Services and their vehicles to operate safely in, on and around the course. As a consequence you need to be aware of your immediate surroundings at all times.

Disclaimer.

Taking part in Mold Town Council Santa Dash event.

By entering the event you acknowledge that you accept responsibility for any injury or accident which may occur whilst you train for, travel to or from the event, take part in or during the event, save to the extent any accident or injury which is caused by the organiser's negligence.

Participation in an event is entirely at your own risk and by entering the event participants acknowledge that Mold Town Council is NOT liable for injury, loss, death or damage arising from participation in the event save to the extent that it is caused by Mold Town Council negligence. Participants entering the Santa Dash, it is YOUR responsibility to seek appropriate medical advice prior to participation.

Personal health and fitness.

You understand that participating in this event is potentially hazardous and you should NOT take part unless properly trained and capable of completing the full distance. It is your responsibility to make sure you are medically fit and capable of running or walking the distance entered for.

Use of photographs and/or video.

It is presumed by Mold Town Council that implied permission is given to use any photograph or video taken / or submitted before and during the event and may be used for publicity, press coverage or social media purposes, unless explicitly informed to the contrary at the time.
